Young Farmers Sheep Overwintering Competition

Aims of the Competition:

- To develop business skills and encourage the next generation into the agricultural sector
- To encourage young farmers to support local auction marts and experience the live auction bidding system through the buying and selling of store lambs
- To practise the art of stockmanship in the tasks of selection, feeding and selling animals
- To support young farmers with financial independence in a commercial aspect

Young farmers are offered the opportunity to purchase store lambs throughout the autumn sales, feed them through the winter, and sell through spring sales at any United Auctions Market. A key part of the competition is covering the commercial aspects of production through daily liveweight gain and highest feeder's margin categories.

Competition Eligibility:

- All participants must be a full, affiliated SAYFC member
- All participants must be aged 14 or over, and not attained their 30th birthday at the close of the competition

Competition Rules:

<u>General</u>

- 1. The competition will run from 1st September 2021 to 31st March 2022.
- 2. Each competitor can enter each class once. (A maximum 50 lambs per person if all classes entered.)
- 3. 10 lambs per entry per class.
- 4. Lambs must have been born in spring 2021 to qualify.
- 5. Classes are as follows:
 - 1. Native Terminal (Eg. Suffolk, Hampshire Down)
 - 2. Native Maternal (Eg. Scottish Blackface, North Country Cheviot)
 - 3. Continental (Eg. Texel, Beltex)
 - 4. Home Bred Terminal (Both continental and native breeds accepted)
 - 5. Home Bred Maternal (Both continental and native breeds accepted)
- 6. Lambs can be overwintered on grass, forage crops or concentrates (housed or on grass.) The chosen method must be declared on entry form and a cost per head will be allocated from an SAC Consultant.
- 7. All government rules on tagging, movements and registered holdings must be followed.
- 8. Re-tagging of lambs will be accepted up to 20% if a tag is lost. The 10 lambs submitted for judging must be the same 10 lambs entered at the start of the competition.
- 9. Any lamb that dies must be declared. No substitutes will be accepted.
- All lambs must be sold through United Auction marts between the dates of 1st January to 31st March 2022. No dressing of lambs allowed. Lambs are to be sold in their natural state.
- 11. All lambs entered must be overwintered on the chosen holding for a **minimum of 60 days**.
- 12. The stock must be overwintered by the member and must be available for inspection on the farm at any time by the organisers, SAYFC and United Auctions, or their appointed representatives.
- 13. All sheep will be weighed by United Auctions on day of sale and recorded.
- 14. All entries must be sent to janelle@sayfc.org by the 31st December.



A - Purchased Section

- Lambs can be bought from any United Auctions Market between 1st September to 31st December 2021.
- 2. Competitors must enter 10 lambs per class. They can buy a larger pen of lambs and select the 10 they wish to enter, or 'take a cut' of a pen at time of buying inform the auctioneer at time of bidding.
- 3. The 10 lambs entered for each class must be the same breeds no mixed classes.
- 4. The 10 lambs' individual Eid tags, date of purchase and individual weights on the date of buying must be recorded.
- 5. Enter by filling in the attached entry form and handing to an office member of staff at time of payment.

<u>B – Home Bred Section</u>

- Lambs must be weighed and electronic ear tags recorded between dates of 1st September and 31st December to qualify.
- 2. Competitors must enter 10 lambs per class.
- 3. No mixed classes of lambs.
- 4. An average production cost will be applied by an SAC Consultant to rear lamb from birth to calculate highest profit margin category.

Judging Criteria and Competition Categories:

All lambs will be judged on:

- Highest Average Daily Liveweight Gain
- Highest Feeder's Margin
- Highest Profit Margin

If a lamb has died, the average from the remaining living lambs will be used over the full pen. United Auctions will not be held liable for any deaths.

Partnership

This Competition is in partnership with **United Auctions**, who are offering a *Livestock Buyer's Scheme* for Young Farmers participating in the Overwintering Competition. United Auctions are willing to offer partial or full finance for entered animals, the cost of which, plus interest, will be deducted from the sale proceeds. Any resulting profit will be paid to the young farmer. Competitors taking advantage of this facility must abide by the Standard Terms and Conditions of the Stock on Agreement Scheme. To benefit from this generous offer, <u>please register with any United Auction Mart Office **prior** to purchasing any store lambs</u>. Full information and details are available at the Mart offices, or from a United Auctions auctioneer or member of staff.

Additional Information

Government rules and guidelines on tagging, movements and registered holdings must be adhered to. It is not essential to be farm assured to compete.

Registration

There are a number of steps you need to take before you move sheep or goats onto your holding in order to operate within the requirements of the law:

- Firstly, you must register your holding with the <u>Rural Payments and Inspections Division</u> (<u>RPID</u>) through your local office. They will give you a County Parish Holding (CPH) number which is a unique code allocated to the land where animals are kept - this is used when reporting and recording animals moving on to or off your holding.
- 2. You must then inform your <u>local Animal and Plant Health Agency (APHA) office</u> who will give you a herd mark (goats) or a flock mark (sheep) for your holding. The herd/flock mark means you will be able to buy tags and electronic identifiers for your sheep or goats.

You must register your holding within **30 days** from the date you first keep animals.
