North Clay Pigeon Shooting 2024

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. The Competition is open to full members of North Clubs affiliated to the Scottish Association of Young Farmers Clubs.
- 2. <u>Team Entries</u> will be made up of three members, one of whom may be an Associate member. One member of the team must produce a valid shotgun Certificate. SAYFC will follow procedure of venue and any changes will be notified to Clubs.
- 3. <u>Individual Entries</u> clubs / districts are welcome to enter individuals for the competition. All team members are also included in the individual competition.

PROCEDURE

- 1. The competition will be a 50 Bird all <u>round shoot</u> from a variety of fixed traps for all teams. In the event of tie-scoring in either the Team or Individual competition, a shoot-off will be held. Fibre wad Cartridges only to be used.
- 2. All competitors will follow the rules laid down by the British Association for Shooting and Conservation.
- 3. Please note that all competitors must provide and wear ear defenders at all times.

ENTRIES

- 1. Entries and a photocopy of the shotgun certificate must be sent to the Regional Development Officer no later than the closing date stated at the foot of the rules.
- 2. In addition to the team entry Fee, all Teams and individual competitors are required to cover the cost for them taking part in the 50 Bird Shoot. The cost of this is £40 per person IF YOU REQUIRE A GUN AND CARTIRDGES AND £26 Per person IF YOU PROVIDE YOUR OWN GUN AND CARTRIDGES to be paid on the day of the competition.
- 3. In the opinion of and at the Chief Stewards' discretion a competitor or team could be disqualified for ungentlemanly conduct by word or act which is likely to bring the event and/or the YFC into disrepute.
