National Craftsmanship Competition 2025 Rules 'Welly Holder

ELIGIBILITY

The Competition is open to full bona fide members of any Young Farmers Club affiliated to the Scottish Association of Young Farmers Clubs. Please note that any member not able to compete on the day of the National Competition due to them reaching above the age of consent will be ineligible to compete in the preliminary rounds leading up to this event.

SCORING CRITERIA

In judging each article, the judges will be asked to allocate marks as follows:-

Workmanship 10 marks
Design & Use of Colour 3 marks
Suitability of Materials 3 marks

Degree of Difficulty 4 marks 20 marks

PROCEDURE

- 1. The Welly Holder should be delivered by the individual to the Young Farmers Centre, Ingliston by the date shown at the foot of these rules.
- 2. The Welly Holder must be **no larger** than 50cm x 50cm x 50cm
- 3. The Welly Holder may be created using any material, and in any design.
- 4. Displays will be on show within the Centre from the date of arrival (Sunday BEFORE the Show). Displays should be delivered to the Centre on or before Sunday 15th June at 12pm.
- 5. Results will be announced on Saturday of the Show.
- 6. Entries can be collected from the Centre on the Sunday of the Show any time between 4.00 pm and 6.00 pm.
- 7. The National competitions committee will appoint a judge for this competition whose decision will be final

ENTRIES

Entries are invited for 2 sections.

- SECTION 1 Junior Members under 18
- SECTION 2 Senior Members aged 18 and over

Members cannot have attained their 30th birthday by the date of the national competition.

Competition Date: Sunday 15th June 2025
Entry Criteria: Club to National
Entry Fee: £20 per entry
