

TEN-PIN BOWLING COMPETITION 2025/26

ELIGIBILITY

1. The competition is open to full members of Clubs affiliated to the Scottish Association of Young Farmers Clubs. up to two members may be associates.
2. Members who exceed the competing age on the day of the National competition are ineligible to compete even in preliminary rounds leading up to the event.
3. Teams should be mixed and must consist of at least one member of the opposite sex.

PROCEDURE

4. The National Final will be played in a straight event, each team participant playing 2 games. The best eight scores from each team will count. In the event of a tie, the 9th score will be taken into consideration by the Chief Steward.

ENTRIES

5. Entries will be allowed as follows: - TEAMS will comprise up to six members.
6. Teams will be required to pay for their own lanes and shoe hire.
7. Competitors must report to the Steward in charge at the venue on the day of the competition.
PLEASE NOTE THAT DUE TO NEW RULES, ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IF THEY ARRIVE AFTER THE CLOSING DATE UNLESS PRIOR ARRANGEMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE. IF YOU ARE NOT ABLE TO CONFIRM THE FINAL TEAM BY THE CLOSING DATE, A WRITTEN CONFIRMATION MUST BE SENT TO CONFIRM THAT YOU WILL HAVE A TEAM AND IT WILL BE FINALISED ASAP. THIS WRITTEN CONFIRMATION MUST ALSO BE RECEIVED BEFORE THE CLOSING DATE.
8. In the opinion of and at the Chief Steward's discretion, a competitor or team will be disqualified for ungentlemanly conduct by word or act which is likely to bring the event and/or the YFC into disrepute.
